Benito Juaraz, like today's politicians, is remembered more for his eccentricities and fashion choices than his policies. He worked as a statesman in 19th Century Mexico – a clue about the food served in Benito's. He also wore a range of marvellous hats for which he became known. Seven restaurants in, and with brilliant reviews, Benito introduces his headgear to Bromley.

Handled by the lot at CantorMasters, Benito's is built around large social spaces, above restored, stripped (and stripy) wooded floorboards encouraging slack, casual bar-style service. Warm copper table tops and rich earth reds are homely touches for Benito's ancestors to see, yet London is felt in the concrete ceilings and low-hanging lamps that wouldn't be found in 19th Century Mexico. The traditional food is closer to Benito's heritage, and an insistence on Margaritas at the bar is more than fine with us.
